The **Registered Nurses Foundation of Ontario (RNFOO)** is looking for student nurse volunteers to join its Fund Development, Marketing and Communication (FDMC) Committee.

RNFOO is a charitable organization that provides scholarships and grants to nursing students and to practising nurses who are furthering their education or undertaking an innovation project.

We are seeking student nurse volunteers to help us *plan and execute an outreach strategy* to increase awareness of our organization among nursing students, within the broader nursing community, and with the general public. We need *volunteers who understand how to use various social media platforms and approaches* to connect with all these audiences. Activities would involve *gathering contact information for nursing leaders in academic, hospital, long term care, community, and public health settings*. As a committee member, you would also participate in committee meetings and provide advice regarding outreach and communication strategies for students and others.

We are asking for a commitment of at least one calendar year (September 2020 to August 2021), with approximately 8 – 10 hours of work per month.

RNFOO has a nearly 50-year history of providing awards and scholarships to registered nurses, registered practical nurses, and nursing students who are seeking financial assistance for undergraduate or post-graduate nursing education. Volunteering with the RNFOO Fund Development, Management and Communication Committee is an opportunity to support and extend this important work and enhance the capacity of RNFOO to invest in the next generation of nurses.
