

# RNFOO 2019 Awards Available to Graduate Level Nursing Students

The process for distributing RNFOO Awards and Scholarships is based on the academic year. The on-line application process for these awards opens in December, and closes in mid-January.

Winners of the RNFOO Awards and Scholarships will be celebrated at the RNFOO Gala on Wednesday, May 1, 2019.

## **Dorothy Ferguson Scholarship** (1 x \$2,000)

To support a nursing student who is enrolled in a baccalaureate or graduate nursing degree. Applicants must demonstrate outstanding leadership potential. Preference will be given to full-time students.

## **Dorothy Monteith Scholarship** (2 x \$2,000)

To support students who are enrolled in graduate degree in nursing with a focus on health policy, and who demonstrate outstanding leadership potential. The successful applicant may be studying full-time or part-time.

## **Dorothy Wylie Scholarship** (1 x \$1,500)

To support a student studying nursing leadership at the graduate level.

## **Dr. Hildegard E. Peplau Award – Mental Health Nursing Interest Group (MHNIG)**

(1 x \$1,000)

To support a student enrolled in graduate level education in psychiatric/mental health nursing. Preference will be given to those whose focus of study includes an interpersonal perspective in nurse-client, family, peer, or community relationships. Preference will be given to members of the RAO MHNIG.

## **Dr. Joan Lesmond Memorial Scholarship** (1 x \$2,500)

To support a Registered Nurse who is studying diversity at the graduate level. Applicants should demonstrate that their studies are focused on equity and inclusion in the nursing field.

## **Dr. Sheela Basur and GE Oncology Nursing Education Scholarship** (1 x \$2,500)

Applicants must be Registered Nurses, residing in Ontario, enrolled in a university graduate program with a focus on oncology, and intending to practice in Ontario following completion of their program.

## **Evelyn Cameron Memorial Bursary - Pediatric Nurses Interest Group (PedNIG)** (2 x \$1,000)

To support Registered Nurses who are enrolled in education at the baccalaureate or graduate level with a focus on pediatric nursing. Applicants must be members of the RAO Pediatric Nurses Interest Group, and must demonstrate commitment to advancing the practice of pediatric nursing in Ontario.

## **Joyce Shack Memorial Bursary** (1 x \$1,200)

To support a student enrolled in a graduate level program whose career goals are focused on nursing administration. Preference will be given to students who demonstrate active involvement and leadership in the community.

### **Julie Hall Scholarship for Neuroscience Nursing** (2 x \$1,500)

To support Registered Nurses enrolled in education at the baccalaureate, masters or doctoral level with an interest in any aspect of the broad specialty of neuroscience nursing. Applicants may be involved in any area of neuroscience across the lifespan and the continuum of care. Applicants must demonstrate excellence in neuroscience nursing and indicate how they contribute to the advancement of clinical practice, education, or research within this specialty.

### **Maternal Child Nurses Interest Group (MCNIG) Scholarship – Doctorate** (1 x \$1,000)

Applicants must be Registered Nurses enrolled in an Accredited University Doctorate program with a course or research project/thesis in maternal/child or neonatal nursing within the hospital or community setting. Applicants must be members of MCNIG and not a recipient of this scholarship within the past 3 years.

### **Maternal Child Nurses Interest Group (MCNIG) Scholarship – Masters** (2 x \$1,000)

Applicants must be Registered Nurses enrolled in an Accredited University Masters program with a course or research project/thesis in maternal/child or neonatal nursing within the hospital or community setting. Applicants must be members of MCNIG and not a recipient of this scholarship within the past 3 years.

### **Mildred Grace Harbour Memorial Scholarship** (1 x \$1,500)

To support a full-time student enrolled in a Baccalaureate program leading to a Registered Nurse designation. Applicants should provide evidence of their ability to inspire others, and their practice of caring above and beyond standard expectations.

### **Ontario Nursing Informatics Group (ONIG) Scholarships** (1 x \$1,000)

To support a Registered Nurse who is enrolled in further education in informatics at the baccalaureate or graduate level. Preference will be given to members of the RNAO Ontario Nursing Informatics Group.

### **RNAO Region 6 Doctoral Scholarship** (1 x \$1,000)

To support a student enrolled in a PhD program in nursing. Applicants must be a member of RNAO Region 6 for at least one year, and be willing to report back to Region 6 about how the scholarship has helped them. Preference will be given to students whose research aligns with an RNAO Best practice Guideline and/or RNAO's values: respect for human dignity, commitment to diversity, inclusiveness, equity, social justice, and democracy.

### **Saint Elizabeth Scholarship** (1 x \$2,500)

To support a nurse (RN or RPN) who is enrolled in education at the Baccalaureate or graduate level. Applicants must show that their career path is dedicated to Community Nursing.

### **Toronto General Hospital, School of Nursing Alumnae Association Scholarship**

(5 x \$1,000)

To support nursing students or Registered Nurses pursuing education at the undergraduate or graduate level. Applicants must demonstrate outstanding potential and/or contributions to their chosen area of practice.
