

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## **Step 2:** Start or continue your your application

Applicants may start application here. You may "Save and Continue" at the bottom of the form page to resume later. Incomplete applications will be listed below and will be deleted by the system after 90 days. Incomplete applications after the application date will not be considered.

Once you submitted your application, it can no longer be edited. You can see or download your completed application in step 3.

## It's a whole new ball game for 2024!

Highlights of the changes in the application process:

The content required is not different from previous years, but the format is new. Most people have found it easier to navigate than our former system.

In the new system, you must complete all required fields on a page before you can access the next page.

HOWEVER, you can go back and revise your answers at any time until you Submit.

Once you click on 'Submit', you will not be able to edit your application.

Office staff can't see any part of your application until you have clicked "Submit".

## **Proof of CURRENT Enrollment**

Applicants must upload documentation proving *CURRENT* (i.e. in the Winter 2024 term) enrollment in a recognized program. Most schools have a down-loadable Confirmation of Enrollment document.

Some schools require that this document be provided by the registrar's office.

Applicants must ensure that the document includes their name and student number. (This is particularly important if you are taking a screen shot of a document.)

#### RNFOO – Reference Letter Guidelines for 2024 Awards & Scholarships Applications

#### To the Applicant:

- Two reference letters must be submitted for your application to be complete. More than 2
  letters cannot be accommodated and will not be attached to your application. If you wish to
  change a referee, contact <a href="mailto:info@rnfoo.org">info@rnfoo.org</a>.
- Choose your referees carefully. They should be able to evaluate and comment on your commitment to the nursing profession, leadership potential, scholarship/academic potential, and/or your contributions (previous or potential) to the advancement of nursing practice.
- One referee must be academic (faculty member, an academic advisor or a clinical instructor)
- Reference letters from family members will not be accepted
- Referees should email completed letters as an attachment directly to <u>info@rnfoo.org</u>.
   (Reference letters sent from the applicant's e-mail address will not be considered.)
- Reference letters are due in the RNFOO office BY 4:00 pm Monday, February 5, 2024.



From H: Are international students with a valid SIN number from Ontario still eligible for the awards?

**Reply**: Yes, as long as a student has SIN and meets the other criteria, you are eligible you can apply.

From K: We need the most recent transcript, right?

**Reply**: Transcripts need to be current ie including marks from the Fall 2023 term.

From J: What does the application review process look like?

**Reply**: There is a link in the "Tips for Success" section on the Application Guidelines page that takes you to a description of the review process.





From L: Do graduate students need to be enrolled in an MN or MScN? Are other masters' programs acceptable (Advanced Health Care Practice - MHSc program)?

**Reply**: Some of the scholarships require that applicants be enrolled in a nursing program. Others accept degrees in related fields, such as Public Health, Informatics, and Business Administration

From L: As a Masters student, is it sufficient to request the official transcript from my current school that shows my grades in the fall term, or do I need to order and submit all transcripts from all undergrad programs at prior schools?

Reply: Reviewers expect to see transcripts from *all* nursing related programs.





From C: I attached my previous term enrollment; is that okay? Can I change it even though I hit "Submit"?

Reply: Part 1: Confirmations of enrollment must be for the Winter 2024 term.

Part 2: Applicants who have clicked on 'Submit' cannot make further changes to the application. In this situation, a replacement document can be sent to <a href="mailto:info@RNFOO.org">info@RNFOO.org</a>. Staff will ensure that it is loaded to the application.

From T: Can we apply to a few awards at the same time?

**Reply**: You should apply for as many awards as you meet the criteria for - there is no maximum. However, you should ensure that you meet ALL stated criteria, and that your statements of explanations are in line with your Career Goals statement.

From K: Does amount of time spent as a member of an interest group matter (for those awards that require it)? Or is it taken into consideration?

Reply: This depends on the interest group. You need to check the criteria for each award. Some groups state 'preference is given to members'. Some groups have different criteria for different awards that they sponsor. If there is no time limit stated in the award criteria, then as long as your membership is confirmed when we check with RNAO you meet the criteria.

From G: Can both referees be academic.

**Reply:** They can, but you should be looking for some balance. They should probably not teach the same course, and they should know enough about you to be specific about your qualifications.

From C: Will RNFOO staff send an email to my references asking for my reference?

**Reply**: No. Applicants must ask their references to submit letters to the RNFOO office. Read the instructions on references carefully to ensure that your application will be scored.

From H: I am in am virtual master's program. Is it ok to have 2 clinical references? I had only one course and my instructor does not know me well enough.

**Reply**: This is a difficult situation. If you can connect with a professor from your Baccalaureate program, that would be better than not having an academic reference.
